

Nominations cannot be made from the floor and the election will not be conducted by ballot when there is only one nominee for each position to be filled. Nominations will be posted in a conspicuous place at the credit union office by Feb. 12 – 35 days before the Annual

The election will be conducted at the Annual Meeting. Irrespective of the number of shares, no member has more than one vote. All elections are determined by a plurality vote. When only one member is nominated for each position to be filled, the chairman of the board may take a voice vote or declare each nominee elected by general consent or acclamation at the annual meeting. No member may vote by proxy. An organization, incorporated or otherwise, holding membership in the credit union may only be represented by one person authorized to represent it, and said authorization shall be maintained on file in the credit union.

Nominations can also be made by petition. Nominees must be made with 1 percent of members' signatures (minimum of 138). Nominations by petition must be sent to Credit Union Board of Director Secretary via registered mail by Feb. 8. Candidates must submit a statement of qualifications and biographical data with the petition.

Brown was the first African American employee of CCFCU where she began as a teller and later worked in the loan department. She's been a member of our board since 2011 and has served in various capacities. She's also a member of the National & Texas Association of Realtors and is currently serving a second term on the Board of Adjustments for the City of La Marque.

#### MR. MICHAEL A. VARELA SR.

Varela graduated from Ball High School and later served in the Navy where he received an honorable discharge in 1975. As a graduate of Galveston College where he earned an associated degree in applied science in Fire Protection Technology, Varela worked as a firefighter for the city of Galveston where he served as Battalion Chief and was later appointed to Fire Chief in 2003. He retired in 2010 after dedicating 30 years to the city of Galveston. He's served on the board and committees of CCFCU in a myriad of roles since 1983 and is currently vice chai<mark>rman of the b</mark>oard. He's also been a part of various organizations on the island. Varela and his wife, Stella, have been married for 46 years and have three children and nine grandchildren.
